

Troop 719 Driver's Information

For activities requiring automobile transportation, the Troop must file a Tour Permit Application with Baltimore Area Council. The permit requires insurance and identification information for each driver. Since it is hard to predict who will drive, the Troop files an application including all possible drivers. If you think you might drive for a Scouting activity, you can help us by providing the information below. To transport Scouts, drivers must be at least 18 years old and have a valid driver's license. The vehicle must have a seat belt for each person to be transported and all occupants must be belted. Minimum insurance limits are as required by the state. Recommended limits for liability and property damage are \$50,000 per person/\$100,000 per accident/\$50,000. If you do not wish to reveal your insurance limits, but have at least the recommended coverage, please enter "\$50,000/\$100,000/\$50,000." You are not covered by BSA secondary liability insurance unless you are properly registered on the Tour Permit. Please indicate any older vehicles to be removed from the list.
